Get approval from district buildings & grounds to hold event; Crystal Boyung chaired event for Badger last few years & is willing to support event for Fair Park; reach out to DJ from Spooktacular to see if available; food trucks/Cousin's subs trailer for food after event.

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## Counselor's Report: Mrs. Biertzer

- 1. **Journeys groups-** K and 2nd grade groups ending next week (8-week group); will be beginning groups at 3rd, 4th and 1st in January.
- 2. **Jump into Your Future Day** Whole school event in coordination with Junior Achievement. Each student will participate in a half day career awareness and activities experience on Friday, Mar. 16th. If you or someone you know are interested in presenting a career that day let me know. We will also need parent volunteers to help with the day in a couple other ways.
- 3. Mr. Brad, **Outreach Coordinator from Friends of Abused Families** has relocated and I just met his replacement, **Katherine Kapp**. She will be coming to team teach 2 lessons with me this year in 2nd-4th grades; first a Respect lesson (in November) and later in the year a Protective Behavior Body Safety lesson. (Jan/Feb)
- 4. **Counselor Connection Classroom lessons** All grades finishing Expect Respect lessons; Finish with emotion management and mindfulness in December and coming back in January; an intro/review of Kelso's Choices in January before 2 lessons in each grade on Protective Behaviors- Personal Body Safety
- 5. PBIS Updates- New puzzle in the lobby has clues to what our next All School Celebration will be once all the pieces are taken down by classes earning 100 falcon feathers; each class is then posting the piece they worked to earn. Also, we continue to have more parents join us for Falcon Frenzies when their child is recognized; we are open up the award giving to other staff member beyond classroom; School goal: reduce physical aggression with acts of kindness; meeting individually to problem solve with students who have had major behaviors for physical aggression; in a bi weekly group if there is 3 behaviors in 3 weeks; 14 students starting mentoring with staff based on identified need
- **6. Fair Park Food Pantry-** (Flyer) we are trying to restock our shelves with kid friendly, low to no prep foods. Sent a message to staff and sharing it with you first. See if we need to do an all school drive after that.
- 7. Perfect Attendance- We just recognized 1st trimester Perfect attendance- 110 kids!
