### **School Board Meeting Recap**

The West Bend School Board held a regular meeting on April 14. The board recognized the West High School Bowling team, ProStart Culinary Competition team, and high school students who received National ServSafe Food Manager Certification.

#### **Gold Medal for Talented Artist**

East junior Vincent Zirbes received a national Gold Medal in the 2025 Scholastic Art and Writing Awards for his drawing "Time's Inescapable Grasp." In June, Vincent and his family will be traveling to New York to attend the awards ceremony at Carnegie Hall. He was one of 110,000 teens who entered more than 310,000 original works of art. Previously, he won four Gold Key Art Awards through the Scholastic Art and Writing Awards and one of those has now won the national award.

#### **Student Council Wins State Awards**

The East and West High Schools Student Council won several awards at the recent Wisconsin Association of Student Councils Convention.

The West Bend Student Council took first place among all state student councils for the Spirit of Excellence award. The Spirit of



Excellence is a portfolio prepared by student council leaders to highlight the activities that their school offered to the entire student body and community. The East and West council won the Region #4 awards, and then was chosen the best of all 12 regions for demonstrating excellence in leadership development, sportsmanship initiatives, school spirit, and service to school and community.

The East and West council also received a gold level award for Best Project, Scrapbook, Banner, and Creative Marketing and a silver level award for T-shirt Design. The advisors are Skip Clark, Alex Ehlke, and Randy Reysen.

At the 2025 Wisconsin Civics Games Playoffs recently, three teams from the West Bend High Schools qualified for the state competition taking place on May 2 at the Wisconsin State Capitol. This is the first time in school and competition history that a school has three teams qualify for the state finals.

The teams answered questions about local, state, and national government. At the state finals, they will compete against other high schools and the winning team will earn scholarships to any



Wisconsin public or private college. The teams are coached by West Social Studies teacher Mark Drake.
