## **Registration for Summer School Continues**

Summer will be here soon! Register your student for Summer School enrichment classes before they are full. All the details of Summer School, such as the list of the many enrichment classes, transportation details, and more, is on the <u>website</u>.

Students and families will soon receive recommendation letters for students in current grades K-7 for summer school reading and math classes. The letters will be sent via Skyward messenger. Students



will be recommended for the math and/or reading classes based on qualifying data or at the request of their teacher. Information on why the student is being recommended and for what class or classes is included in the letter.

Registration for Summer School is completed in Skyward. Dates and locations include:

- Virtual high school classes begin on Tuesday, June 10 and end on August 1.
- Current grades 4K-7 attend beginning Monday, June 16 to Thursday, July 10. Classes run Monday-Thursday.
- Current grades 4K-3 attend summer school at Decorah.
- Current grades 4-7 attend summer school at Silverbrook.
- Current grades 8-12 attend summer school at the high schools buildings beginning Monday, June 16 to Thursday, July 17. Classes are Monday-Thursday.

## **Review Math and ELA Potential Resources**

After close review by math and English Language Arts teachers and administrators, potential new resources for math for students in grades 6-12 and ELA for grade 5 are now available for community review. The recommended math resources are:

- Grades 6-8: Illustrative Math Imagine Learning (Primary Resource)
- Grades 9-12: Illustrative Math Kendall Hunt (Primary Resource)

The recommended ELA resource for fifth grade is Amplify CKLA (Core Knowledge Language Arts). We encourage families and community members to review the proposed materials and share their feedback. Both the math resources and English Language Arts resources are available for viewing at the Education Service Center until April 11 and the West Bend Community Library until April 13.
