



Erica Wanie Beine West Bend West Class of 2014

Whether it was a track, a cross country course, or a classroom, Erica Wanie Beine of the West Bend West Class of 2014 was a champion.

Erica was a 14-time WIAA State Championship qualifier in track and field, including winning the state championship in the 4x400 meter relay in 2014. Also that year, she placed third in the 4x800 meter relay and fourth in the 800 meter run. She qualified for state in track and field in all four years of high school in at least three events each year.

She was also an 11-time conference champion in track and field, including three straight conference titles in the 800 meter run. In 2014, she was the conference champion in the 400 meter dash, 800 meter run, 4x400 meter relay, and long jump.

In cross country, Erica was part of a team that qualified for the WIAA State Championships four times. Her 4,000 meter cross country race time is ranked second in school history and she is one of only two girls in school history to break 15 minutes in the 4,000 meters.

Among the all-time rankings of West High School girls track individual events, Erica is second in the 600, 800, and 1,600 meter runs, third in the 400 meter dash, and fourth in the high jump and long jump.

Erica was named Academic All-State in cross country twice and was the 2014 West High School valedictorian. She attended Marquette University where she competed in track and field in various events.
