



Brad Burns West Bend West Class of 1984

The first part of the father-son duo who have made their mark on West Bend West baseball, Brad Burns, class of 1984, still holds the West record for career strikeouts (316) and single season strikeouts (141).

Brad was captain and team most valuable player of the 1984 WIAA State Championship West baseball team. In addition, he was first team all-state in 1984 and two-time all conference. He had 22 career high school pitching wins and threw a no hitter in 1983.

During his time at West, Brad also excelled on the basketball court. He was first team all conference and honorable mention of the all-state team in 1984, after averaging 22 points and 12 rebounds per game.

Brad played collegiate baseball while attending Dallas Baptist University, lettering in three years. Afterwards, he co-founded the West Bend Baseball Association. He is also a 2004 inductee of the Land O' Lakes Baseball Hall of Fame. Brad brought his talents back to West baseball, serving as an assistant coach from 2003-2017.
