Summer School 2025 Updates and Details

It may be snowy and cold right now, but West Bend School District's Summer School is just a few months away! In fact, registration opens for students in current grades 8-12 on Monday, March 10 and for current grades 4K-7 on Monday, March 17. All registrations are completed using Skyward.

Elementary and Middle Program

The location of summer school for several grades has changed from 2024. Current grades 4K-3 will be located at Decorah Elementary School.

- Program dates: Monday, June 16 Thursday, July 10 (classes held Monday-Thursday each week)
- Program times: Drop off will begin at 7:30 a.m. and pick up will begin at 11:30 a.m.

Current grade 4 will be located at Silverbook Intermediate School this year. Current grades 5-7 will also be held at Silverbrook, just as in previous years.

- Program Times: Drop off will begin at 7:45 a.m. and pick up will begin at 11:40 a.m.

East and West High Schools students, staff, and families are gearing up for the annual Charity Week, February 24 - March 1. This year the West Bend High Schools Student Council will <u>exceed</u> \$500,000 donated to in total charity since the inception of Charity Week in 2004.



One part of the weeklong event is the Charity Dance on Saturday,

March 1 for high school students. This is also a big part of the fundraising as 100 percent of ticket sales (tickets are \$20 each) will be donated to Full Shelf Food Pantry and Regal Ware will match the donation dollar for dollar. The goal is to get 1,000 students to attend the dance and give a donation to Full Shelf for \$40,000!

Grades 6-12 Math Resource Review

In 2023, a Math Program Analysis for grades 6-12 led by the WBSD Teaching and Learning Department resulted in a recommendation to further explore potential new resources. A thorough review of the current math curriculum has been underway, with a focus on improving instructional practices and student achievement.



- A team of educators has evaluated multiple resources using a rigorous screening process and reported its progress to the Curriculum Committee of the West Bend School Board.
- There are multiple options that will be further explored by the team for both the middle school and high school level.
- Teachers will observe these resources in action and continue their exploration for a future recommendation to the Curriculum Committee.
- Any resource that is recommended for consideration will be made available for the community to provide feedback.

5th Grade English Language Arts Resource Review

The West Bend School District previously adopted Amplify CKLA (Core Knowledge Language Arts) as its primary literacy resource for implementation in grades K-4 during the 2024-2025 school year. With elementary schools housing fifth grade in the near future, the district is working to align English Language Arts instruction across grades K-5.



Using the same intensive review process used for a new English
Language Arts resource for grades K-4, a team of educators will begin examining the curriculum and primary resource for 5th grade English Language Arts. The process includes teacher input, classroom observations, and a public review before final recommendation and potential action.


Snowboarding Teams and Skiers Off to State
