Families,

Due to the support of our community and the successful referendum last fall, the West Bend School District is entering an exciting period of transformation. As we prepare for upcoming school reconfigurations, we are pleased to announce leadership transitions that will support students and staff during this time of change.

Beginning July 1, Mrs. Adrienne Schneider, who has served as principal of Decorah Elementary for the past 10 years, will step into a new role as a Curriculum and Instruction Program Administrator for the district. Adrienne's deep expertise will now benefit students across the entire district. We are grateful for her decade of dedicated service to the Decorah school community and know she will continue to make a meaningful impact in her new role.

Succeeding Adrienne at Decorah will be Mrs. Heather Geldnich, who has served as assistant principal at Silverbrook Intermediate for the past 11 years. Heather brings a wealth of experience in school leadership. She will serve as principal at Decorah for the next two years, through its planned closure in summer 2027, after which she will return to Silverbrook as assistant principal when it becomes a K-5 elementary school.

Looking ahead to the 2025–2026 school year, Silverbrook will serve all of the district's fifth and sixth grade students. During that transitional year, we will select an interim assistant principal to replace Mrs. Geldnich. In 2026–2027, Silverbrook will transition to a sixth-grade-only building, and an assistant principal will not be needed.

Please join us in celebrating Mrs. Schneider's contributions and congratulating both her and Mrs. Geldnich as they embark on their new leadership journeys. We are confident these transitions will ensure continuity, care, and strong leadership for our students and staff during the coming years.
