Be Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cheer at appropriate times • Show good sportsmanship • Listen to all staff member directions 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use school-appropriate language at all times • Show good sportsmanship to all players, coaches, referees, and fans, win or lose • Follow all directions and requests from school staff, event supervisors, and police officers immediately • Students should remain seated in bleachers or at designated picnic tables
Be Responsible	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take care of yourself • Turn off or silence electronic devices • Leave your area clean 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Throw away all garbage in trash cans • Report unsafe, disrespectful, or suspicious behavior to a staff member ("See something, say something") • Keep electronic devices on silent and avoid disruptive use
Be Safe	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remain in designated area • Watch where you walk • Report misconduct 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walk at all times-no running chasing, or horseplay • Avoid loitering in bathrooms • Do not climb on fences, picnic tables, or railings • Do not go under, behind, or between the bleachers
Be Ready	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow directions of the leader or speaker • Sit in designated spectator areas 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not bring food, drink, or backpacks into the games • If riding a bike or scooter to the game, it must be left in bike racks near the school or just outside the fence near the home side entrance of the football stadium - the West Bend School District cannot guarantee anything that is not locked will be safe
